Articulation of Transfer Agreement

Bryan College and Cleveland State Community College hereby enter into a partnership that promotes academic opportunity for students through this transfer and program articulation agreement. This academic alliance allows transfer of an Associate of Applied Science degree and related transfer curriculum credit, offered through Cleveland State, to the Bryan College Aspire degree completion program. This agreement between Bryan and Cleveland State is to be periodically reviewed, and revised if necessary, by the partner institutions.

This agreement is intended to lead to and promote the awarding of the Associate of Applied Science degree and other transfer curriculum credit by Cleveland State and to promote the awarding of the Bachelor of Science degree by Bryan College. Students who complete seventy-six (76) credit hours within the specified associate degree and transfer curriculum will be granted junior year status upon directly entering Bryan College's Aspire degree completion program.

Bryan College will apply all seventy-six (76) credit hours described herein toward the bachelor degree described herein. Credits will be applied as appropriate, first toward general education requirements for the Aspire program, then to requirements for the academic major. Remaining transfer credits will be accepted as electives. Transfer students, under this agreement, with seventy-six (76) credit hours, will need only an additional forty-eight (48) credit hours to complete all academic requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration.

No transfer credit will be accepted without official transcripts. Transfer students must have a cumulative grade point average equivalent to a "C" or higher. Transfer courses must not duplicate other courses for which credit has been awarded. The parties recognize that the Cleveland State course in Managerial Finance (ACC/MGT 2240) is not duplicative of the Bryan course of the same title, but is introductory for an upper-level managerial finance course. Developmental or pre-college courses are not accepted for transfer. A maximum of twelve (12) credit hours of Cleveland State Cooperative Education courses may be transferred.

Bryan College agrees that the courses listed on the attached document, identified as either the Associate of Applied Science Degree or the Transfer Curriculum, meet all Bryan General Education requirements for the Bachelor of Science, Business Administration Major offered through the Aspire program, other than those scheduled by Bryan within the Aspire curriculum. The attached document may be updated, as required, upon the formal approval of the appropriate deans of both Bryan College and Cleveland State Community College.
