

Nursing Program Pre-Admission Testing Guidelines

Cleveland State Community College

The Nursing Program pre-admission test requirement is a product of Evolve Reach Elsevier Review and Testing. This test is administered via the internet by appointment in the college's Testing Center (TC). This administration program is powered by Health Education Systems, Inc. (HESI). The test is often referred to as the "HESI". It should be noted that there are many tests available through HESI and the procedures and guidelines below pertain only to the "HESI" admission test required as part of the screening process for admission to the Cleveland State nursing program.

1. Students will register for the test date and time through the CougarNet student account. Any exceptions will be at the discrepancy of the Dean of Health and Wellness and must be scheduled by a TC staff member.
2. The testing fee of \$30 is to be paid through the Business Office. Make up testing fee for missed session is \$50 to include a \$20 rescheduling fee.
3. The student will bring a receipt and the testing ticket (available online) to the testing session.
4. The student will submit a photo ID before testing.
5. Students cannot schedule more than one testing session at a time.
6. No refunds are given for missed testing sessions.
7. Students who miss a scheduled testing session and desire to re-schedule must check with TC staff for available dates AND submit receipt/s for \$50 before scheduling the make-up date. Re-scheduling and second attempts must be arranged by TC staff.

The test is available the months of October, November, January and February.
