

Dual Enrollment New Student

- ☐ Complete the Hepatitis B Form. One box must be checked. This form must also be signed by a parent if you are not 18.
- Must include a copy of your high school transcripts and ACT, SAT, ACT Plan or PSAT Scores with this registration packet. To qualify for dual enrollment, you may be a freshmen, sophomore, junior or senior and meet a minimum of 3.0 high school GPA and minimum ACT subscore in the subject area you wish to take, 18 sub-score for English or 19 in Reading and Math (course info next page).
- EVEA: All students must provide a copy of a TN Driver's license or birth certificate in order to receive state benefits (lottery).
- □ Lottery Grant Confirmation Signature Sheet: You have to choose one of the options:
 - You have or intend to complete the online lottery registration and wish to have one or two courses credited.
 - 2. You do not want the lottery.
 - 3. You have used your lottery at another college. Choose one option, sign, provide Social Security Number and Date. You will not be credited any lottery money if this form is not completed (Social Security Number is required by the state for lottery grant). If the state website has given a prompt that you have reached four courses and are now borrowing against your HOPE, you must print, sign and turn in that form with this packet as well.

■ Lottery Grant Eligibility:

High School juniors and seniors may receive the Lottery Dual Enrollment Grant (DEG) which will pay towards the balance of one course per semester. To qualify for the additional course coverage towards the balance of two courses, students must meet the current Hope Scholarship criteria of a 3.0 high school GPA or cumulative ACT score of 21 or higher. Home school

students qualify by 21 ACT only. To receive the DEG, students must complete the online registration prior to turning in their application packet, and renew it each semester or academic term.

Students who receive the DEG amount for more than four (4) dual enrollment courses over the junior and senior years (\$1200 total) will have the amount reduced from their HOPE Scholarship on a dollar for dollar basis. College courses attempted and the years enrolled as a dual enrollment students shall not count against the 120 semester hours and five years limitation. For more information, and for the DEG application, please visit http://www.tn.gov/collegepays.

To be eligible for a dual enrollment grant for any semester beyond the first semester of receipt, the student shall continue to meet all eligibility requirements for the grant and shall achieve a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 for all postsecondary courses attempted while participating in the Dual Enrollment Grant program.

- □ Lottery Registration: List Cleveland State as the college when registering. The question is referring to the college for your dual enrollment class *Not* where you are going after graduation. If you put the wrong school, the only way to fix this problem is to contact the Lottery Call Center. Do this right away because it will delay payment! For help with registering or any problem, call the Lottery Call Center at 1-800-342-1663.
- Read, understand, and sign where necessary regarding Authorization to Disclose Academic Information to Parents, the section about Lab Fees and How to Set Up your CougarNet Account.
- Once your application is processed ALL students need to set-up their CougarNet Account. This is where the student will check grades, courses registered for, email, etc. Payments for tuition can be made online through the students CougarNet Account.
- ☐ Fill out the **Course Registration Form** completely with your name, address, social security number, email address, and phone numbers. Indicate what high school, private, or home school that you attend. Fill in the class or classes you want to take with all required numbers, class names, the location of your class, and if you are using the lottery. Indicate at the top of the page that you are a new student.
- □ Campus ID Card is required if you are taking classes on any Cleveland State campus. On the main campus in Cleveland, the ID machine is located at the Help Desk in the Administration Building. For students closer to Athens campus, you can get an ID made there.
- ☐ State of TN Employee Discount Form: (included in packet) Must be completely filled out including signatures from student, parent and employer. Please return with completed packet.
- Need-Based Scholarships: (included in packet) If you

qualify be sure to include proper documentation to be considered. Please return all documents with completed packet.

Lab Fees

- Any required Lab Fees (ex: Math Lab Fee) should be paid by the deadline listed on the next page in the chart, or you can refer to the
 website under Dual Studies link. If not paid by the deadline, a hold will be put on your account and you will not receive a final grade for
 classes and you cannot request that your transcripts be sent to another institution.
- These fees are your responsibility to pay.

How to set-up CougarNet Accounts:

In order to determine your CougarNet username you'll need to search for it using your student ID number and birthday.

- 1. Go to the Cleveland State website and click on the CougarNet Link.
- 2. Click "what's my username" at the bottom of the CougarNet login screen.
- 3. Fill out your student ID number and birth date.
- 4. Click "Search."
- 5. You should now see your CougarNet username. Your default password is your six-digit birthday. For examples, if you were born on July 14, 1985, your password would be 071485.

How to pay

Check your CougarNet account for balance of tuition/fees and credits.

If balance of fees are not paid by the deadline, the student will be dropped from all classes in which they were enrolled. Cleveland State is promoting the opportunity for students to be able to take one Dual Enrollment course per semester tuition-free whether it is paid by Dual Lottery Grant, Cleveland State or combination of both.

Options for payment

- In person: Tuition balances can be paid at any of our three campus locations (Cleveland, Athens or Monroe County). The Athens Center and Monrore County Center **DO NOT** take cash.
- Online: Pay with a credit card online through your CougarNet account.
- Payment Plans: A dual enrollment student may choose to pay his or her balance of tuition in multiple payments. To review the payment plan
 options, students should log in to CougarNet and select the "My Account" tab, then "Account Balance," and then "Pay Now." Be sure to follow
 deadlines.
- CougarNet Accounts: A HOLD will show on your account. Therefore, to add or drop a class you must contact the Dual Enrollment Office at 423-614-8743. or 423-614-8734.

Hepatitis B Immunization Health History Form All Students Must Complete

The General Assembly of the State of Tennessee mandates that each public or private postsecondary institution in the state provide information concerning hepatitis B infection to all students matriculating for the first time. Tennessee law requires that such students complete and sign a waiver form provided by the institution that includes detailed information about the disease.

The law dose not require that students receive vaccination for enrollment. Futhermore, the institution is not required by law to provide vaccination reimbursement for the vaccine.

Hepatitis B (HBV) is a serious viral infection of the liver that can lead to chronic liver disease, cirrhosis, liver cancer, liver failure, and even death. The disease is transmitted by blood and/or body fluids and many people will have no symptoms when they develope the

disease. The primary risk factors for Hepatitis B are sexual activity and injecting drug use. this disease is completely preventable. Hepatitis B vaccine is available to all age groups to prevent Hepatitis B viral infection. A series of (3) doses of vaccine are required for optimal protection. Missed doses may still be sought to complete the series if only one or two have been acquired. The HBV vaccine has a record of safety and is believed to confer lifelong immunity in most cases.
